1 = BTEC Extended Certificate (one A Level equivalent); 2 = BTEC Diploma (two A Levels equivalent); 3 = BTEC Extended Diploma (three A Levels equivalent)

In order to study a BTEC Diploma (two A Levels equivalent), a pupil must select the matching parts “1” and “2” e.g. BTEC Sport 1 and BTEC Sport 2. In order to study a BTEC Extended Diploma (three A Levels equivalent), a pupil must select the “1” and “2” matching pair as well as the equivalent “3” e.g. BTEC Sport 1, BTEC Sport 2 and BTEC Sport 3.

Choice Key



These subjects can be chosen with any subjects from columns B, C, D and E, including those coloured red providing, where relevant, the matching parts “1” and “2” have been chosen. Subjects identified as “3” can only be chosen with the matching parts “1” and “2”.



These subjects can be chosen with subjects from columns A, B, C, D and E, excluding those coloured red. BTEC Creative Media and BTEC Design and must be chosen across both columns where they appear.



These subjects are BTEC Extended Certificates (1 A level equivalents) and can be chosen with subjects in columns A, C, D, and E. They can also be combined with the matching parts 2 and 3, where relevant, to form part of larger BTEC qualifications.



These subjects can only be chosen with subjects in column A and/or the subjects coloured green in column B and must be chosen with the matching part “1”.

Music Technology (orange square) is timetabled outside the column blocks, but cannot be chosen alongside subjects in columns E and C. *History of Art is as yet unconfirmed due to the wider national picture.
